3. Strong hands-on experience of LAMP stack
 - a. Installing, configuring and maintaining Linux OS, specifically Debian-based
 - b. Experience with Apache 2 Web Server
 - c. Database administration experience with SQL, MySQL
 - d. Development experience using PHP as main programming language

4. Self-starter who has the initiative to begin and lead projects independently
5. Excellent communication and teamwork skills

Additional preference will be given to candidates who meet these criteria:

6. Knowledge of healthcare IT standards (i.e. HL7 and DICOM)
7. Experience with cloud service providers (i.e. AWS and GCP)
8. Good understanding of Networking fundamentals such as (IPSec, ICMP), Application Protocols (DNS, HTTPS, SSH) and SSL/TLS.
